APPLICATION FOR FLAMENCO DANCE SCHOLARSHIP 2017/ 2018 SEASON

PURPOSE

This Dance Scholarship has been established to provide talented young participants the opportunity to study and improve their artistic abilities.

APPLICATION

All Santa Barbara County residents are eligible to apply for scholarships. **Applications must be mailed to ¡FLAMENCO! SANTA BARBARA at the address listed below.** Applications will be reviewed by the ¡FLAMENCO! SANTA BARBARA Scholarship Committee. Notification will be sent to each applicant regarding the status of their application.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must have taken classes in Flamenco dance for at least 2 years in the same studio
2. Minimum age is 6 years of age on September 30, 2017. Maximum age is 20 years of age through 12/31/2017
3. Applicant's family must have a financial need and submit copies of their income taxes for the last two years from custodial parent(s) / guardian
4. Teacher recommendation is required

REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete application including supporting documents must be submitted by deadline. See below.
2. ¡FLAMENCO! SANTA BARBARA must confirm receipt of the application in order for the application to be processed. If you do not receive a confirmation contact us immediately
3. Only applications received by mail to ¡FLAMENCO! SANTA BARBARA will be considered
4. Teacher recommendation letter (may be sent separately via email to sbflamencodance@gmail.com)

AWARDS AND TIMELINE

1. Award will consist of partial tuition for each student
2. The tuition balance will be borne by the responsible parties (i.e.) parent or guardian
3. Mail the application postmarked by September 30, 2017. All forms must be mailed together
4. Applicant will receive official notification of scholarship award by early November 2017
5. A written thank you letter for our records is required by the scholarship recipient and must be received by November 25. Also sign and return the Dance Contract by November 25.
6. Funds will not be released to the dance studio if a written thank you letter is not received by November 25, 2017. The letter must be mailed to ¡FLAMENCO! SANTA BARBARA at the PO Box address listed. **DO NOT MAIL OR DELIVER THE THANK YOU LETTER TO THE STUDIO**

PURPOSE

If you are granted a scholarship from Flamenco Santa Barbara, you will be sent a contract to sign. Flamenco Santa Barbara scholarship is requiring this in good faith to show that the dance studio will receive the efforts of both teacher and student in a positive dance experience.

ATTENDANCE AND COMMITMENT

The dancer is required to come to class on time and without fail unless they are sick or have previously made arrangements with their dance teacher for a good reason. Dance classes should be considered a top priority over other after-school or outside activities. The recipients and / or a responsible party of any scholarship recipient will also be asked to participate in volunteerism and be required to be active in all dance school activities for fundraising. Failure to participate in rehearsals or primary dance school activities may result in forfeiture of future scholarships.

COURTESY AND RESPECT

Please show the dance studio, dance director, dance teacher and fellow dancers respect and conduct yourself in a courteous manner. Disrespectful behavior is unbecoming and looks poorly on the studio, which will be taken into consideration during future scholarship reviews.
